Taste Profile: Crisp Wine Color: White

Tasting Notes: Mida and Jean, very approachable, and grassy (both women are avid gardeners). Varietal is Trebbiano with a bit of low residual sugar, and white fruit. Super easy to drink. Sauv Blanc's twin

79% Trebbiano, 14% Muscat Canelli, and 7% Riesling

Aromatics: cut grass, lemon custard, gooseberry, honeydew Flavors: honeydew melon, medium acidity, and a hint of tannins

Winemaker's Notes: After a tough vintage, this wine came out reminiscent of a Sauvignon Blanc with a great mouthfeel

Taste Profile: Dry

Wine Color: Red

Tasting Notes: Strawberry and Flint, low in alcohol with a soft mouthfeel, medium plus acidity. This will be your summer porch pounder.

Aromatics: strawberry shortcake, grapefruit, candied peaches, flint Flavors: tart grapefruit, medium+ acidity, very subtle tannins complete a silky finish

Taste Profile: Smooth Wine Color: Rose

Tasting Notes: 30% Mourvedre, 20% Malbec, 16% Carignan, 16% Tempranillo, 12% Petite Sirah, 6% Cabernet Sauvignon

Color: brick red color with mahogany rim

Aromatics: red cherry, raspberry, fig, leather, toffee, lilac

Flavors: Bright acidity, mild tannins, and bright red fruit on the finish
